Bike Party

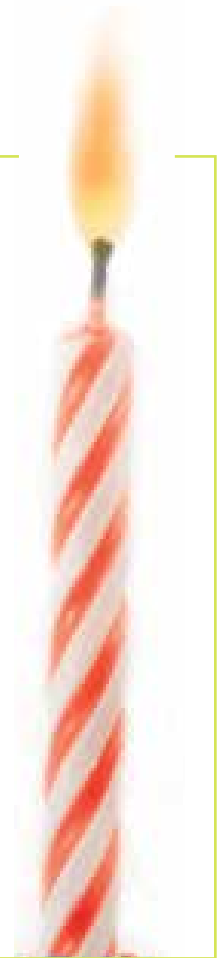
Cost \$230 - 20 Children Limit
