### Definitions of Swim Periods

#### Lap Swim

The pool is open to pass holders and daily guests who wish to swim laps. During crowded lap swim times, preference will be given to adults, ages 18 and older. It may be necessary for lifeguards to place swimmers in lanes according to speed or for swimmers to circle swim.

#### Open Swim

The pool is open to pass holders and daily guests. There will be 3 lanes available for lap swim. Children who are under the age of 12 must be accompanied by someone 16 years or older.

### Buffalo Grove Park District Locker Room Age Policy For Aquatic Facilities

Children 5 and up are not permitted in the opposite sex locker rooms. You may elect to do one of the following:

- Ask the manager for assistance.
- Come prepared to swim, and send the swimmer through the proper locker room and meet them on the deck.

## Lifeguards & Swim Lesson Instructors

Applications for year-round and summer employment are now being accepted on-line at [bgparks.org](http://bgparks.org). Potential lifeguards must have successfully completed, be currently enrolled in, or have intentions of enrolling in a Starguard lifeguard training course prior to beginning work as a lifeguard. We will offer one lifeguard class in late May that is limited to 10 participants. Potential instructors must enjoy working with children in a fast paced environment and should have CPR and First Aid training. VSI is preferred, but we are willing to train exceptional candidates. Hours include weekday evenings and weekends during the school year. Pay starts at \$8.75 per hour and up.

### Rental Fees

#### Ultimate Party

\$350 - Up to 180 guests and 2 hours of exclusive use.

#### Splash Bash Party

\$200 - Up to 65 guests and 2 hours of use, which may be shared with an additional 2 other Splash Bash Party rentals. Any additional guests must pay an entrance fee of \$2 per person.

#### Mini Splash Bash Party

\$175 - This fee includes 2 hours of use and admission for up to 50 guests, though seating is limited to 38 guests with room for standing. Any additional guests must pay an entrance fee of \$2 per person.

#### Party Deck

\$175 - This fee includes 2 hours of use during regular hours (shared time with general admission guests) and admission for up to 65 guests. Any additional guests must pay an entrance fee of \$2 per person.

#### Table Rental

\$25 per table for 2 hours during public hours.

#### Nonresident

\$30 fee for all parties.

## Pool Passes

Passes follow a school year calendar until we open the outdoor facilities. They will be valid until May 25, 2018, and are available for purchase. Did you purchase pool passes this summer or last fall? Your current pool passes will just need to be renewed. You can download a pass form on our website at bgparks.org on the Aquatics page. Save yourself a trip, and fax or mail it in.

### Pool Pass Policies

- Families may now add babysitters and nannies to their family pass.
- Only the person who purchased the passes may use them. Passes may not transfer ownership.
- A fee of \$10 is charged to replace lost or stolen passes.
- Pool passes must be present to enter the pool. Patrons or families without a pool pass will be required to pay the daily admission fee.

### Purchasing Pool Passes

Pool passes are available to Buffalo Grove Park District residents and nonresidents ages 3 years and older. Purchasing a pool pass is an economical way to enjoy the warm waters and fun activities at the Buffalo Grove High School Natatorium. All passes require a photo of the pass holder, and are issued only at the Alcott Center during normal business hours. The rates listed below will go into effect on Monday, December 4.

Everyone entering the pool during a public swim period must have a current pool pass or pay the daily admission fee, even if you do not intend to swim. A complete set of pool rules and policies are available at the pool.

## Swimming Lessons

Each swim time will be broken into different levels. It is not necessary for you to know your child's swim level, as all children will be tested on the first day of class and placed in the appropriate level. All 6 levels will be taught in the Park District swimming classes. If you have any questions or concerns about our pool or our programs, please ask the Manager/Coordinator on duty for clarification. Swimming lesson fees will not be prorated for any reason, and we do not offer make-up lessons. **Please note:** Due to staffing requirements, you must register for all swim classes at least 2 business days prior to the start of class. No walk-in registrations are accepted the day class starts.

### Teens & Adults

### Infant Swimming Resource

Your child can learn critical Self-Rescue™ skills in Infant Swimming Resource's (ISR) survival swim lesson program. Lessons are one-on-one with Meredith Dean, an ISR certified instructor. The parent, or caregiver, watches every lesson from the poolside. Students attend 10-minute lessons every Monday-Friday (5 lessons per week). Babies 6 to 12 months are taught the rollback-to-float sequence. The child is taught breath control, correct floating posture, and skills to attain a back float and remain floating for varied periods of time. Lessons typically last approximately 4-5 weeks for most infants, but vary per child. Your child must be crawling or be able to roll over both ways and sit independently on land in order to start lessons. Children 12 months or older who are walking are taught the swim-float-swim sequence - swimming in a face down position, using arms and legs; rolling onto their back to a survival float and then flipping back over to continue swimming. ISR has numerous safety protocols to provide the safest possible lesson. It typically takes 6 weeks to learn all the skills, but varies per child. A required initial registration fee is \$105 per new student, and \$35 for returning students. This process provides ISR with an in-depth look at your child's health, medical history, and aquatic environment. Your child's registration information is kept confidential and reviewed only by ISR certified personnel. Once approved, you will register in 2-week increments, with fees being \$90 for residents, and \$113 for nonresidents per week. Classes will take place at the Fitness Center between 10 am - 4 pm in the lap pool beginning January 8. ### Water Babies

These classes for infants and toddlers require active, in-water participation from a parent or guardian. Classes include group and free time activities to help new swimmers adjust to a large body of water and become comfortable in and around the pool. This program is designed as a fundamental introduction to our instructional youth program. Children must wear a swim diaper under their swimsuit. (DH)

Class includes group and free time activities to prepare your toddler for instruction without parent/guardian participation. Children must wear a swim diaper under their swimsuit. In-water participation from a parent/guardian is required. (DH)

### Semi Private Lessons

### Private Lessons

Participants will follow the guidelines of the Learn To Swim program levels 1 - 6. Private lessons are ideal for those wanting to learn to swim at any age. These lessons will help develop and refine strokes so students can swim with ease, efficiency, power and smoothness. These lessons are also designed to help focus on water safety skills, while progressing through various swim strokes. The registration fee includes 6 lessons of 30 minutes each and will be personally adjusted to the needs of the student. Private lessons are provided with a 1:1 student to instructor ratio. **No class on January 26 and February 2.** (DH)

### Swim Team Prep

Is your child thinking about joining a swim team in the future? This class is structured to give your child an exposure to competitive swimming, with extra practice in each of the competitive strokes (freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke and butterfly). In addition, there will be an emphasis on endurance, flip turns, and diving ability. Classes will be run clinic-style, and you can expect to see stroke refinement and improvement in overall performance. This course will have a ratio of no more than 10 swimmers per instructor. Participants must be able to swim 50 yards freestyle continuously, and have passed the Buffalo Grove Park District Learn-to-Swim Level 4 or an equivalent. (DH)
