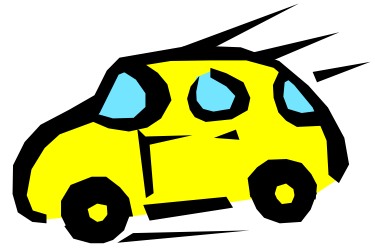

Welcome to Tiny Travelers Camp. We are delighted that you can join us! Your summer will be filled with wonderful activities and fun places to visit. This is a great opportunity to spend time with your child. We welcome and encourage your participation in class. When you join in the fun, your child will want to as well.

You and your child will spend most days at Alcott enjoying art, songs, games and other camp-type activities. On 4 days we will meet at places of interest. Juice or water and snacks will be provided when we are at Alcott and snacks when we are traveling.

On the first day of class you will receive more information and directions for each of the travel days. You will provide your own transportation and meet us at these sites. I will also email it to you to refer back to. Trip fees will be paid for the child and 1 parent or caregiver per child. Refunds will not be given for any trips or class days missed. When we travel, plan to arrive 5 minutes early so we are ready to start at 10 am. Due to classroom size and reservations, no siblings or other adults may attend any classes or travel days.

Because a parent or caregiver will also attend Tiny Travelers camp, there is no Parent Info Night/Meet and Greet as other camps have. We will see you on the first day of camp!
