Pick up/Drop off

We will meet every day at Tripp School Elementary School, located at 850 Highland Grove Rd in Buffalo Grove. Drop off and pick up will be in the front of the building. Camp begins promptly at 9 am and ends at 3 pm. Drop off starts at 8:50 am, and pick up promptly at 3 pm. If you want to escort your child to the door, you must park your car in the parking lot on the side of the building. You cannot park your car in the pickup/drop-off line.

What to bring to camp

Every day, your child will need to bring the following to camp (make sure it is labeled)

- A backpack for all of their belongings.
- Dance shoes or clean tennis shoes
- Camp attire that is comfortable enough to allow full movement.
- Towel, underwear, extra clothes & bathing suite for swim davs
- Sunscreen
- Campers script & pencil (provided)
- Sack lunch and a drink (we do not have access to a refrigerator, plan accordingly)
- A water bottle & a healthy snack for midmorning (Snacks must be NUT FREE)

Swimming

Campers will attend swim lessons at Buffalo Grove High School on Tuesdays & Thursdays. And have open swim time at Willow Stream Pool on Wednesdays. We suggest campers wear their swimsuit to camp on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, as we leave for the pool shortly after arrival. For all swimming days, please make sure your camper has a swimsuit, towel, and a full change of clothes. Campers can wear flip-flops to the pool. All campers will be given a swim test on their first day at the pool and placed into appropriate swim lesson groups.

Field Trips

We will be going on 2 field trips each session. Campers need to wear their camp T-shirt for all field trips. Details about each field trip will be posted on the Band App. You can view the camp calendar for all of the field trip information as well as special camp-themed weeks.

The end of session performances

At the end of each session, campers will put on a show at Tripp School, where family and friends are invited to come and see all the hard work they have been doing. More information will be sent home in the weekly camp newsletter and on the Band App. In the first session, campers will work on songs and scenes from *Seussical*, and in session 2, they will work on *Seussical Kids*.

<u>Performances for the 1st session:</u> Wednesday, July 3, at 10am (Yellow Stars) & 11am (Red Stars). <u>Performances for the 2nd session:</u> Thursday, Aug. 1, at 10am (Yellow Stars) & 11am (Red Stars).

- Alert us in writing of any dietary restrictions, or allergies that your camper might have.
